About Hearing Loops

- Hearing Loops are the gold standard for assistive listening systems and are strongly preferred by users. Hearing loops
 are the easiest to use just click a button on the hearing aid or cochlear implant to instantly connect to the room's PA
 system. No equipment to borrow. Discrete.
- To be effective, hearing loops must meet the IEC 60118-4 Hearing Loop International Standard.

About Assistive Listening Systems (ALS)

- If a location does not have a hearing loop, they should have a FM or IR system. Under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the following places (employment, state and local government, businesses, and nonprofit organizations) are required to have an assistive listening system, either a hearing loop, FM system, or infrared system:
 - 1. In ALL indoor or outdoor areas or rooms, with a public address system.
 - 2. In all Courtrooms
 - 3. Where Effective Communication is needed, such as service counters, rooms without public address systems, etc. Places of worship are commonly exempted under the ADA, but depends on activities, funding sources, and state or local building codes or regulations. For full inclusion, many places of worship wonderfully choose to have an ALS.

- All facilities are REQUIRED to post signage. Also consider including graphics on websites, in programs, and in marketing.
- All Type II facilities are REQUIRED to provide public notice: information as to the "existence and location of accessible services, activities, and facilities." Type III facilities are strongly recommended to provide the same information.
