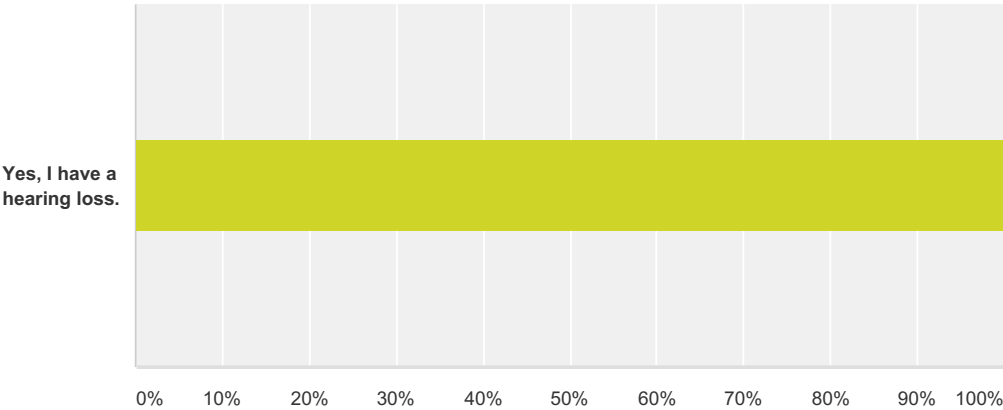


Q1 Please confirm that you have a hearing loss (often called hard of hearing or hearing impaired). If you do not have a hearing loss, please stop here and do not take this survey...

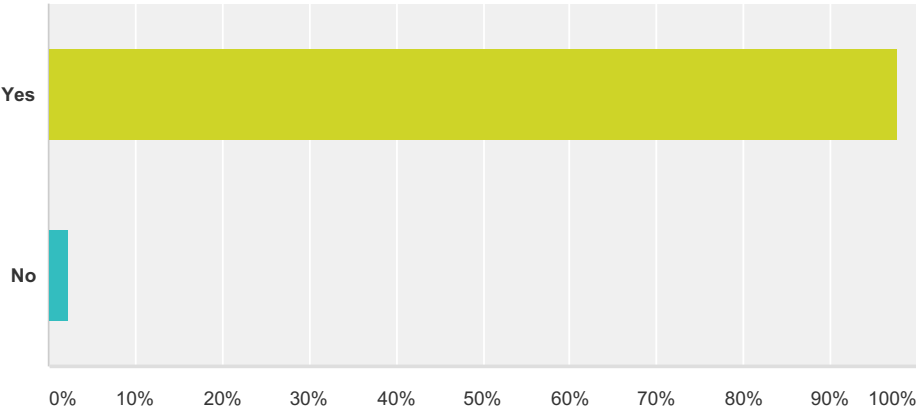

Q2 Do you have hearing aids or a cochlear implant (CI)?

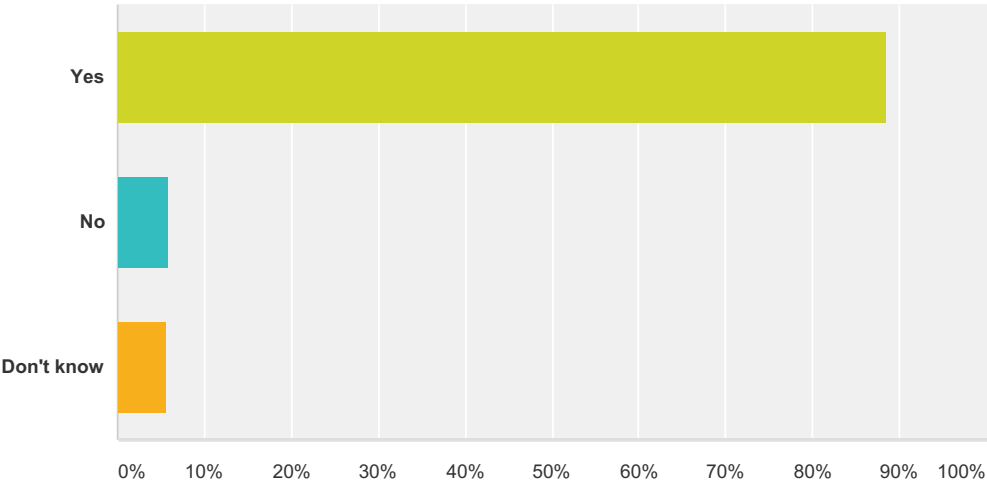

Q3 If you have hearing aids or a cochlear implant, are they equipped with telecoils (often called t-coils or a telephone switch)?

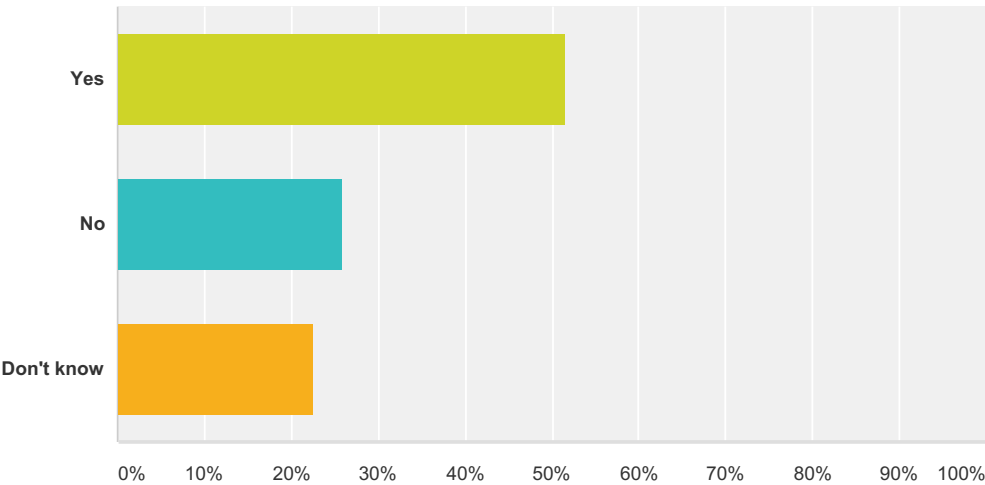

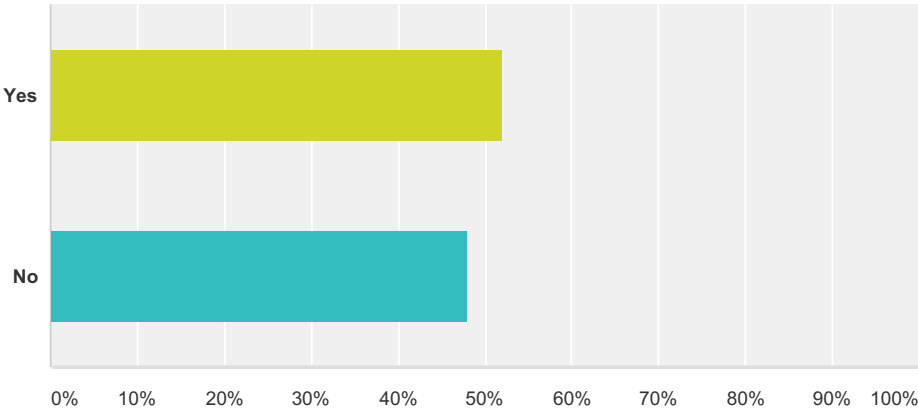

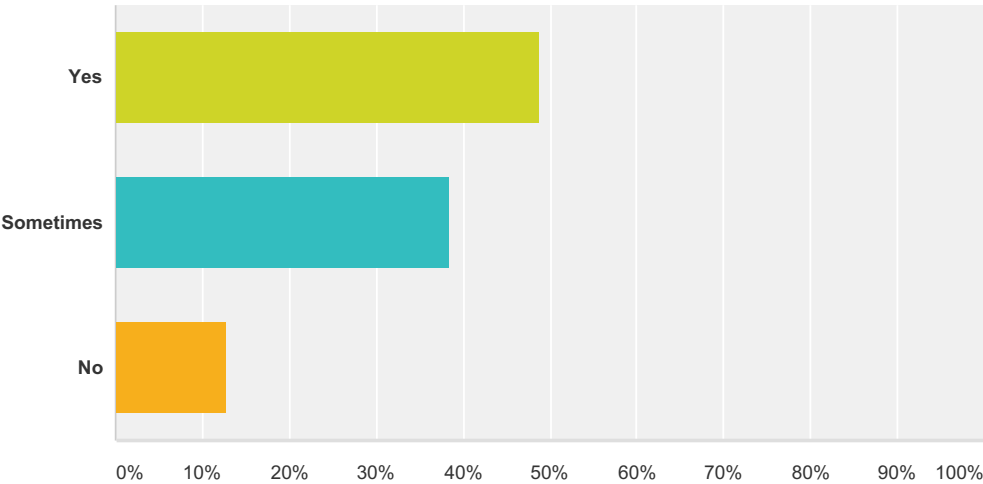

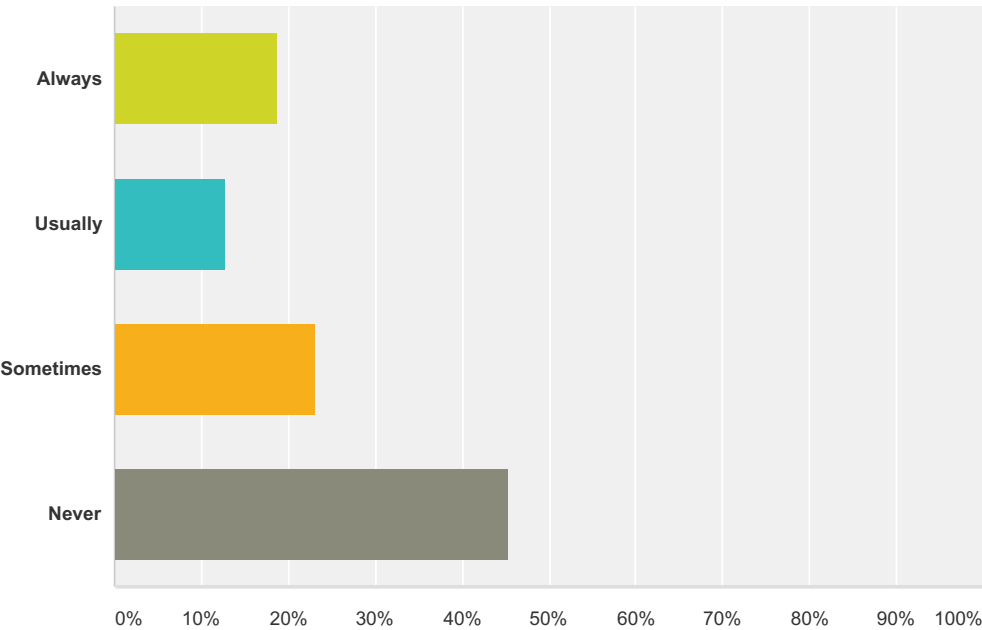

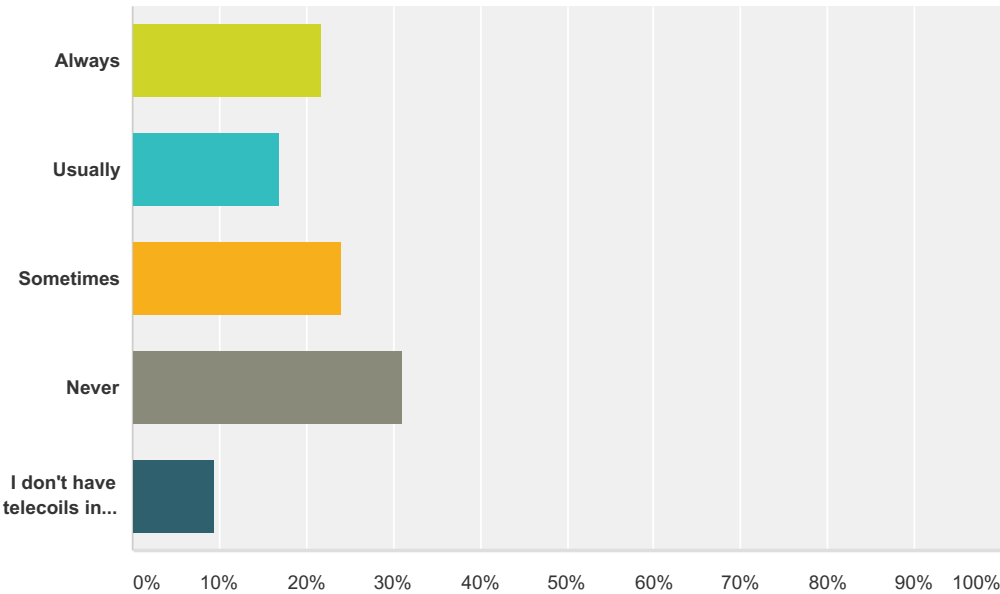

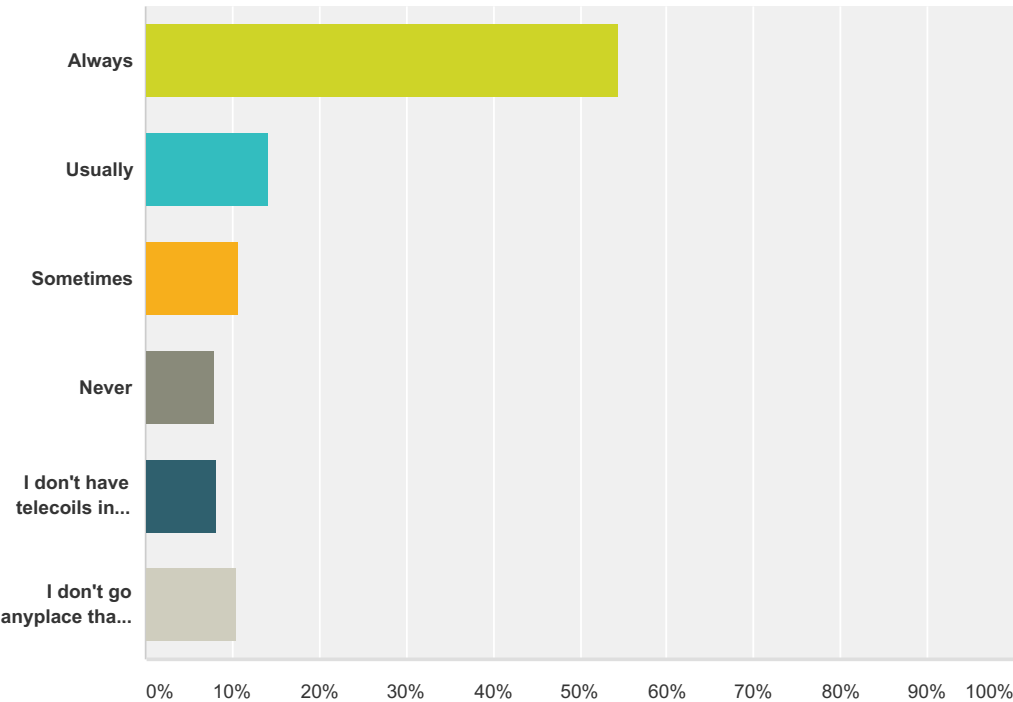

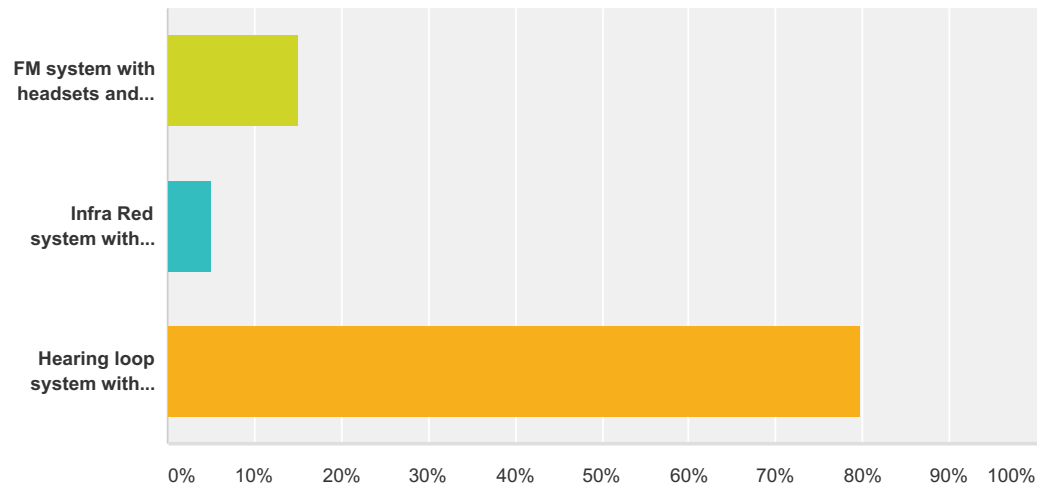
